

Donations to support an Afghan Family

HIAS has contacted the Synagogue Coalition for the Refugee and Immigrant Crisis to assist in acquiring household goods for an Afghan family that has recently resettled in the US.

Background

We are assisting a young couple with three children, a 13 year old girl and boys 3 and 4. They arrived in May, on a Special Immigrant Visa granted for individuals who worked with the US government or military, and are living in a small 2 bedroom apartment in Queens.

Needs

The family already has many of their basic needs and we are providing other household items that they still require. They are in a furnished sublet so no major furniture is needed. The list requested by the family & HIAS may be found at SignUp Genius:

How to help - Review the list detailed on SignUp Genius

- Select the item(s) you can supply
- Select “Submit & Sign Up” to provide your contact info
- Bring your items to our collection site (see date and time below)
- Please be considerate and only supply items in good condition and as described in the listing
- **Collection & Delivery**
 - We will collect your donations outside Congregation Ansche Chesed, West 100th Street and West End Avenue between 9:00 AM and Noon, on Sunday June 25
 - We will then load our vehicles and deliver everything to the family
 - Alternatively, you may ship smaller (less than 20 pound) items to: SCRIC c/o Davidson, 380 Riverside Drive #3D New York, NY 10025 for arrival prior to June 24.
- **Volunteer**
 - On collection day, we will need assistance in loading our truck and delivering everything to the family. The sign up for these slots is at the end of the SignUp Genius list.

Please note: We have not yet obtained size information for the girl’s clothing and will add these items to the list as soon as possible.

HIAS will supply tax donation receipts for those who would like them. Please keep records of purchases or donations. More information will follow on this.
