WHY IS THIS BATHROOM ALL-GENDER?

For many transgender people and people who don't conform to societal gender norms, using a public restroom is a daily struggle. Trans and gender expansive people are often harassed, physically assaulted, or questioned by authorities in both men's and women's bathrooms if they are assumed to be in the wrong bathroom.

All-gender restrooms provide access to safe bathrooms and changing areas for people of any gender identity and presentation. They also provide safe spaces for those who need the assistance of a personal care attendant or those with small children.
